Matthew 5:16

Gentleness	Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and <i>gentleness of Christ</i> (II Cor 10:1).
Meekness	Now I Paul myself beseech you by the <i>meekness</i> and gentleness <i>of Christ</i> (II Cor 10:1).
Honoring Parents	He went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was <i>subject unto them</i> (Luke 2:51). When Jesus therefore saw his mother, he saith, <i>Woman, behold thy son!</i> (John 19:26).
Compassionate	When the Lord saw her, <i>he had compassion on her</i> , and said, Weep not (Luke 7:13). Jesus saw a multitude, was <i>moved with compassion</i> , and he healed their sick (Matt 14:14). Jesus said, <i>I have compassion on the multitude</i> , they have nothing to eat (Matt 15:32). Shouldst not thou also have had <i>compassion, even as I had pity on thee</i> (Matt 18:33)?
Friendly	Greater love hath no man than this, that <i>a man lay down his life for his friends</i> (Jn 15:13). <i>I have called you friends</i> ; for all things I have made known unto you (John 15:15).
Loving	<i>Jesus wept</i> . Then said the Jews, <i>Behold how he loved him</i> (John 11:35-36)! Having loved his own which were in the world, <i>he loved them unto the end</i> (John 13:1).
Loyal	Jesus answered, I have told you that I am he: <i>let these go their way</i> (John 18:8).
Forgiveness	She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, <i>Neither do I condemn thee</i> (John 8:11). Then said Jesus, <i>Father, forgive them</i> ; for they know not what they do (Luke 23:34). And when he had spoken this, <i>he saith unto him, Follow me</i> (John 21:19).
Prayer	He went out into a mountain to pray, and <i>continued all night in prayer to God</i> (Luke 6:12). <i>He prayed more earnestly</i> : and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood (Luke 22:44).
Submission	He prayed, let this cup pass: <i>nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt</i> (Matt 26:39). Though he were a Son, <i>yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered</i> (He 5:8).
No place to devil	The prince of this world cometh, and <i>hath nothing in me</i> (John 14:30). Jesus answered and said unto him, <i>Get thee behind me, Satan</i> (Luke 4:8).

Obedient to God	My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work (John 4:34). The Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him (John 8:29).
Glorify God	Father, glorify thy name . I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again (John 12:28). Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee (John 17:1).
Baptism	Jesus said unto him, for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness (Mat 3:15).
God's word	But he answered and said, It is written (Matt 4:4). Jesus said unto him, It is written again (Matt 4:7). Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written (Matt 4:10).
God's words	Jesus answered, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God (Luke 4:4). The word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken (John 10:35). I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob (Matt 22:32)? If David then call him Lord , how is he his son (Matt 22:45)? Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments (Matt 5:19).
Gracious	And all bare him witness, and wondered at the gracious words (Luke 4:22).
Civil Authority	Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's (Matt 22:21).
Offence	Notwithstanding, lest we should offend them , go thou to the sea (Matt 17:27).
Children	He was much displeased, and said, Suffer the little children to come unto me (Mk 10:14).
Truth	God is a Spirit: they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth (Jn 4:24). And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free (John 8:32).
Priorities	How is it ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business (Lu 2:49)? But seek ye first the kingdom of God , and his righteousness (Matt 6:33).
Zeal	For it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up (John 2:17).
Courage	When the time was come to die, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem (Luke 9:51).
House of God	Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise (Jn 2:16).
Humility	After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet (John 13:5). We are unprofitable servants : we have done that which was our duty to do (Luke 17:10).
Service	Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister (Matt 20:28).
No threats	Who, when he suffered, he threatened not (I Pet 2:23).
No reviling	Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again (I Pet 2:23).
Trust in God	Who committed himself to him that judgeth righteously (I Pet 2:23).
Emotional	Jesus wept (John 11:35).
Prudent	Behold, my servant shall deal prudently (Isaiah 52:13).
Time conscious	I must work while it is day : the night cometh, when no man can work (John 9:4).
Sense of scripture	Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, But I say unto you (Matt 5:21-22). But if ye had known what this meaneth , I will have mercy, and not sacrifice (Matt 12:7).
Loved sinners	I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven ; for she loved much (Luke 7:47). Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him (Luke 15:1). Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house (Luke 19:5). For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10).
Hated the Self-Righteous	I came not to call the righteous , but sinners to repentance (Luke 5:32). He spake this parable to those trusting they were righteous, and despised others (Lu 18:9). Ye are they which justify yourselves before men ; but are abominable to God (Luke 16:15).
Scorned scornors	Give not that which is holy unto the dogs , neither cast pearls before swine (Matt 7:6). Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind ; both shall fall into the ditch (Mt 15:14).
Godly friends Blood brothers	Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it (Luke 11:28). My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it (Luke 8:21). He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them , he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him (John 14:21).
Conditional love	But Jesus did not commit himself unto them , because he knew all men (John 2:24). Having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end (John 13:1). Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you (John 15:14).
