THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Jesus spoke of Noah and the flood as a definite historical person and event (Matt 24:37-39). Therefore a person cannot be a Christian and deny the Genesis account of Noah, the ark, the flood and the careless evil generation that was destroyed.

Did you notice God's appraisal of the natural sinfulness inherent in the hearts of Noah's family? God said "the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth" (Genesis 7:21). Since all the human race came from those eight individuals, we understand that every member of the human race is born with a sinful nature. Total depravity not only means each person is born with a nature prone to sin, but also that every person of every race is a sinner by birth.
