THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:
Whenever you or I believe the LORD has been ordering our circumstances (remember that Sarai said, "The LORD hath restrained me from bearing"), then let us decide right now that we will "Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him ... fret not thyself in any wise to do evil ... those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth" Ps $37: 7,8,9$. Let us not try some scheme of the flesh as did Sarai.

Do you want a real life proof of the inspiration of Scripture? God so accurately foretold the nature and history of the Arabs, which nearly 4,000 years have confirmed, that this prophecy (Gen 16:10-12) is an incontestable argument for the inspiration of the Bible!

4. Multiply thy seed exceedingly, a son, his name Ishmael, a wild man, his hand against every man and every man's hand against him, he shall dwell in the presence of his brethren.
5. Thou God seest me.
