## THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

The chapter begins with the LORD visiting Sarah in miraculous power so that she conceives and bears Abraham a son in her old age at the time He had spoken of. The chapter ends with Abraham calling on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God. As in the case of Abraham and Sarah, the LORD has been attending to all the details of your life, from its beginning to its end. However trying (testing) your circumstances, "The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms." Deut 33:27.

When God confirmed that Abraham was to send Ishmael and his mother Hagar away from Isaac, though it was very grievous to Abraham, he rose up early in the morning, and obeyed. Let us likewise obey!
