THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Although God allows manifestations of evil supernaturalism, as the magicians turning their rods into serpents and water into blood, their power is Divinely limited and notably inferior to the LORD as seen when Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. Remember Jesus healed many a devil possessed person. Jesus always had and has absolute authority over one or many devils. Jesus healed many (Mt 4:24; 8:16); a dumb man possessed with a devil (Mt 9:32-33); two men living in the tombs (Mt 8:28-34). Nothing is too hard for our Lord Jesus Christ (Mt 15:30-31)!

We are to have no contact with the devil and his unclean spirits. Today there are increasing forms of the occult which we totally avoid: horoscopes, fortune cookies, Harry Potter, spiritism, mediums, witches & wizards, ouija boards to name a few. Should we face what appears evil supernaturalism in a person, let us remember and heed our Lord's word, "This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting" Mk 9:29.
