THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Who of the three men, on the hill top in the sight of Joshua fighting Amalek, was the most important? Only when the rod of God was held up by Moses' hands did Israel prevail in the battle. But Moses could not hold his hands up all day. Without Aaron and Hur staying up his hands, the battle was lost. All three were necessary for victory.

Are you fulfilling your responsibilities today for your family, toward some friend, toward the other church members, toward our pastor, at your employment, toward your rulers? "Two are better than one: ... And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken" (Eccl 4:9, 13).
