THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

The children of Israel had a covenant relationship with the LORD on the basis of the book of the covenant (v 7) and the blood of the covenant (v 8). The book speaks of God's revelation of truth, particularly concerning salvation, which otherwise we could never know. The blood speaks of the required atoning sacrifice of a perfect righteous life (Christ's prefigured by a lamb) for a sinful life (sinners such as you and me) that His elect might stand before Him justified.

Rejoice! Christ the LORD, our Substitute in dying for us says: "I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive forevermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and death" (Rev 1:18).

Rejoice! Our Good Shepherd declared, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me" And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand" (John 10:27-28).

HELP:

- 1. Moses, Aaron, Nadab, Abihu and 70 elders of Israel (v 1).
- 2. "All the words which the LORD hath said will we do" (v 3).
- 3. Moses, burnt offerings and peace offerings (vs 4-5).
- 4. Half the blood was sprinkled on the altar, half on the people with Moses saying, "Behold the blood the the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words" (vs 6-8).
- 5. 40 days and 40 nights (v 18).
