3. What command of Saul distressed his army and made them very faint?

4. Because of the above command, what sin resulted among Saul's troops that evening? ______

5. Why did Jonathan disobey the above command of his father?

THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Do you admire and love Jonathan and his armourbearer? I do! Jonathan knew that the LORD could "save by many or by few." His armourbearer answers him, "I am with thee according to thy heart." What a team! Two young men, trusting God, begin a great victory over the Philistines which Saul and his army complete.

Do not despise the day of small things (Zech 4:10). When the LORD is leading and working great things are possible and likely!

Take care that you do not make rash, unwise or needless rules (as Saul did) which your family cannot reasonably and profitably keep and which you will find difficult to inforce.
