## THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Solomon sinned in the sight of the LORD by marrying multiple wives (Deut 17:17). He added to his evil doing when his wives turned his heart after Ashtoreth, Chemosh, Molech, Milcom and other strange gods; and he even built high places to worship these abominations. Therefore the LORD said He would rend the kingdom from him and give it to his servant. However the LORD spared Solomon from the breakup of the nation during his lifetime, "for David thy father's sake" (v 12). The LORD referred to "David my servant" (vs 13, 32, 34, 36, 38) repeatedly as the reason for His gracious dealings with Solomon and the nation. David had his failures, but the LORD commends him for following the LORD with a perfect heart (vs 4, 6).

Love only what God loves, and hate everything that God hates. Do you wish to be married? Bestow your love only on one who loves the LORD so that you marry "only in the Lord" (I Cor 7:39).
