ANALYSIS:

1. The Psalmist asks the LORD for help because there is such a shortage of what kind of men?
2. List all the references to the speech of the ungodly.
3. What causes the LORD to arise, and what does He do for the poor and needy?
4. Name three things spoken about the words of the LORD.
5. Wickedness becomes open and approved when what kind of men

THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

The ungodly puff at the LORD'S people with their falsity, flattery, duplicity and vanity of speech. The hallucinations of so-called scientists ranting their theories of evolution, exaggerated and baseless promises of professional politicians, the godless and immoral fallen standards of society and proud and vain criticisms of the Bible are all deceitful propaganda to be endured by God's children. But God's words are pure and preserved for ever! Hold them fast!

Let us learn Psalm 12:6-7. Memorize it word perfect, if at all possible. Notice "The words of the LORD are pure words..." Yes, the WORDS of our Bible are inspired and are God's words! Cherish every word of your Bible!

What are some single words or phrases of our Bible that are very precious, comforting and instructive to you today? Do you know where they are found?

HELP:

- 1. Godly and faithful (v 1).
- 2. They speak vanity, flattering lips (twice), tongue that speaketh proud things, with our tongue, our lips are our own, him that puffeth at him (vs 2-5).
- 3. The oppression of the poor and the sighing of the needy calls the LORD to action. He will set him in safety from him that puffeth at him (v 5).
- 4. They are pure words, The LORD shalt keep them, The LORD shalt preserve them for ever (vs 6-7).
- 5. Vilest men (v 8).
