THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

In this 4th chapter of Isaiah, we see that when the LORD washes away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and purges the blood of Jerusalem, they shall be called holy. This chapter is looking ahead to the time when the Lord Jesus Christ purged our sins by the sacrifice of himself on the cross of Calvary. "Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us" (Heb 9:12). "For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified" (Heb 10:14).

Are you thankful that the Lord Jesus Christ obtained eternal redemption for you? Because of what he did for us, how ought we to live? "But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy" (I Peter 1:15-16).
