## THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

When was Jesus tempted? After His baptism. After the Holy Spirit came upon Him. After He had received His Father's approval. After being led by the Spirit into the wilderness. After fasting and no doubt praying for 40 days. This record suggests the devil will likely attack us when we are obeying the Lord.

We must never misuse a scripture to break or violate another scripture (like the devil did in verse 6). Paying attention to context will save us.

We read that Jesus' fame was widespread, due in part as a result of his healing people. How many different kinds of people's problems were healed according to verse 24?

## HELP:

- 1. He was led up of the Spirit into the wilderness (v 1).
- 2. It is written (vs 4, 7, 10).
- 3. The devil left him, and angels came and ministered to him (v 11).
