## Matthew 16; August 5; Peter's Confession of Christ

ANALYSIS:  1. When the Pharisees and Sadducees again asked Jesus to show them a sign from heaven, what sign did He offer them?
2. What was Jesus warning His disciples about when He said, "Beware of the Pharisees and Sadducees"?
3. In answer to Jesus question, "Whom say ye that I am?" what was Peter's answer?
4. What did Peter do and say that caused Jesus to say to him, "Get thee behind me, Satan; thou art an offence unto me"?

## 5. When Jesus comes in the glory of His Father, what will He do to every man?

## THINGS TO THINK ABOUT:

Being a true follower or disciple of Jesus is costly. Jesus asks His followers to deny self, take up his personal cross and follow Him. He will lead us to new experiences, and away from unworthy people, places and practices. Are you a disciple? His way is always best!

What aspect of discipleship do you need to correct and improve for the glory and honor of Jesus? Be specific by naming it, write it down, plan what you should and can do to improve, and begin to work our your salvation in this area (Phil 2:12-13).

## HELP:

- 1. The sign of the prophet Jonas (v 4).
- 2. The doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees (vs 6, 12).
- 3. Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God (v 16).
- 4. Peter had rebuked Jesus, when He revealed that He would suffer and die and be raised again the third day, by saying, "Be it far from thee, Lord; this shall not be unto thee" (22).
- 5. Then He shall reward every man according to his works (v 27).
